

Campaign for Emperor and Empress 7

Applications will be accepted from July 5th 2010 and must be handed into a member of the College of Monarchs, or EPAMA Board member no later than midnight August 1st 2010

The non refundable application fee of \$100 must be submitted with the application form and must be witnessed by the receiving party.

Campaign

1. The Campaign will start with the official Introduction of Candidates on August 28th and any pre campaign material in any form will immediately disqualify the applicant.
2. Each candidate must host a campaign event the net proceeds of which should benefit EPAMA. This is exclusive of any and all events hosted by EPAMA or ISCOSEPA during the campaign period.
3. Voting day will be Saturday September 18th from 2.30pm – 9.30pm.
4. The Location of the voting will be inside the Oasis Lobby, as this is a neutral location. This is to be fair to ALL potential candidates for E & E 7.
5. The candidates must be at the ballot box at 2.30pm to witness and sign the ballot box before the commencement of voting.
6. Once the candidates have voted they must leave the immediate voting area, and are not permitted to re enter the voting area until the ballot box is being sealed at 9.30pm.
7. They will witness and then sign the sealed ballot box which will remain in the voting establishment until the Dean of the College, the Manager of the Oasis and one other independent member of the community convenes for the purpose of counting the said ballots.
7. Each candidate is allowed 1 scrutineer in the voting area during the election process that scrutineer must identify themselves to the election committee prior to taking their place.
8. The individuals counting the ballots MUST keep the result secret until the official announcement at the Coronation Ceremony on September 25th 2010.
9. The Ballots must be kept for at least 24 hours following Crowning along with the results and no longer than 7 days. This is to allow time for the candidates to call for a re count or any dispute resolution that may come from the vote. Once the seven days has passed and there is no investigation the ballots must be destroyed.
10. No personal attacks between the candidates will be acceptable in any format; verbal, written or in any electronic format.
11. It is the responsibility of the Dean of the College and President of EPAMA to insure that the above process is fair and by signing this form the accepted candidates swear to abide by the above rules and regulations. Failure to sign this document will result in the disqualification of the application without the refund of the any and all fees.
